In this block, we will explore:

- What causes and effects are How one event (the cause) leads to another event (the
 effect).
- Examples in different subjects How cause and effect appear in history, literature, science, and more.
- Critical thinking skills How to analyze and predict outcomes based on cause-and-effect relationships.
- Writing and discussion How to clearly explain cause and effect in essays, reports, and debates.

Every action has a reaction, and every event is linked to something that caused it. Cause and effect help us explain why things happen, whether in history, science, literature, or daily life.

In this unit, we will:

- Identify causes (the reasons something happens) and effects (the results or consequences).
- Analyze real-world examples to see how events are connected.
- Learn to use signal words like *because, as a result, due to, therefore*, and more.
- Understanding cause and effect is essential in many subjects, from literature and history to science and everyday problem-solving. This concept helps us analyze why things happen (causes) and what happens as a result (effects).

Why Is Cause and Effect Important?

- Critical thinking: helps you analyze events, decisions, and patterns.
- Problem-Solving: identifies reasons behind issues and ways to address them.
- Academic success: used in essays, experiments, and historical analysis.


By the end of this block, you'll be able to identify cause-and-effect relationships, explain them clearly, and use this knowledge to think more critically about the world around you.
