There are many different kinds of adjectives, but the ones that we are going to focus on are called attributive adjectives. Attributive adjectives are words that will expand on specific traits, qualities, and features.

Attributive adjectives modify more than just people, including observations, size/shape, age, color, origin, material, and qualifier adjectives. This means that they are not limited to describing just personality, but also things like fabric, vehicles, towns, and more (basically any noun).

When using adjectives to describe a person's personality, you can use one of two types of words: positive or negative.

When you use a positive adjective, you are creating a positive image of the character. Negative adjectives, on the other hand, spotlight the negative characteristics of a person (or character). These words are powerful in creating reader opinions, so choose the words wisely to communicate clearly.
