There is/there are

Are used to say that an object or a person is located in a specific place.

- There is= singular. Regularly is used a/an
- There are= Plural

Example:

There is a banana/ there's a banana in the basket
There are bananas/ there're bananas in the basket

Negative form

There is not a banana-There isn't a banana
There are not bananas-There aren't bananas

Yes/no Questions

Is/are+there+complement

Is there a banana?

Yes, there is/ No, there isn't

Are there bananas?

Yes, there are/ No, there aren't
