There is/there are

Are used to say that an object or a person is located in a specific place.

- There is= singular. Regularly is used a/an
- There are= Plural

*Example:*

*There is a banana/ there's a banana in the basket*

*There are bananas/ there're bananas in the basket*

Negative form

*There is not a banana-There isn't a banana*

*There are not bananas-There aren't bananas*

Yes/no Questions

Is/are+there+complement

*Is there a banana?*

*Yes, there is/ No, there isn't*

*Are there bananas?*

*Yes, there are/ No, there aren't*
