The student applies the future tense to make predictions about plans and weather in social and work setting through the communicative skills in a natural and respectful manner.

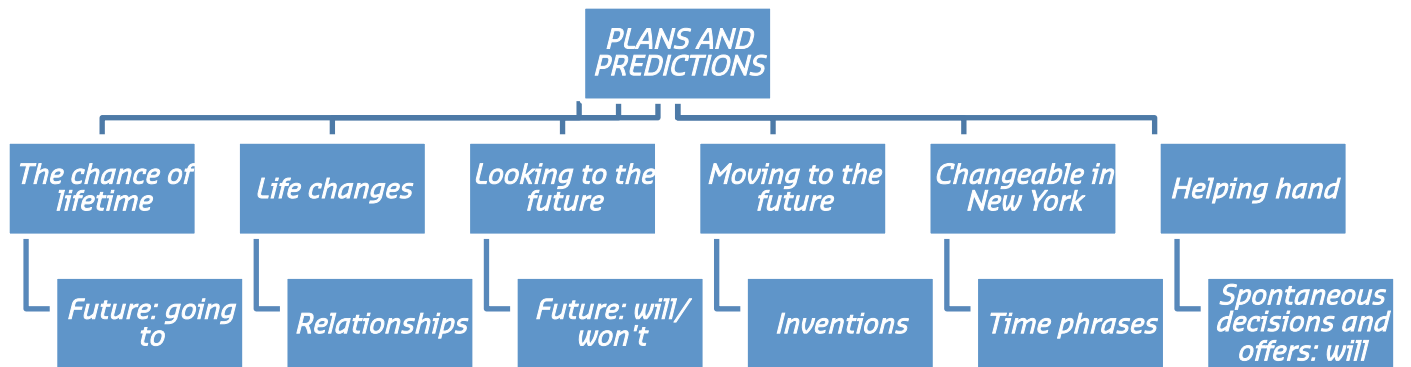
