First Conditional With Unless

Unless basically means the same that **if... not**.

Example: **Unless** you study, you will fail. It is the same that: **If** you do **not** study, you will fail.

We can use **Unless** in the first, second and third conditional, but at this time we use it with the first conditional.

Remember that tenses with first conditional is present in the If clause, and in the main clause is in present or future tense.
