

## Zero Conditional Vs First Conditional

As we saw, zero conditional describes situations that are always true. We use present tense in both clauses: if and main clause.

Tell Mary if you see her.

I get up at six o'clock if I go to school.

We also practiced the first conditional; it is used to speculate about possible situations that can really happen at present or in future. We use the If clause in present and the main clause in future tense.

If Alice studies hard, she will pass the exam.
