## INTRODUCTION

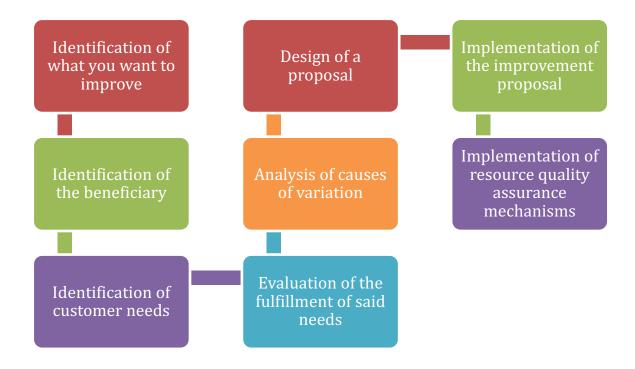
