You will learn how to say where you and other people are from, and what jobs or activities they do.

This is important if you want to get to know someone a little bit deeper, knowing how to ask for little things like this can make a big difference when trying to speak to someone in English and knowing them better.

I’m from Brazil. (Add the country)

or

I’m Brazilian. (Add the nationality)

She’s from Russia.

or

She’s Russian.

They’re from the USA.

or

They’re American.
