

ASK AND ANSWER QUESTIONS ABOUT LEISURE ACTIVITIES

In your free time, you might enjoy things like reading, playing games, watching movies, or going for a walk. These are called leisure activities. Talking about them in English helps you express what you like to do for fun and also helps you learn what others enjoy.

This section will help you ask and answer simple questions like: “What do you do in your free time?” or “Do you like playing soccer?”

Talking about your free time not only helps others know you better, but also shows your personality. Everyone enjoys something different – some people like quiet hobbies, others prefer active ones. Sharing what you do for fun is a great way to make new friends or start conversations in English.

How to Talk About Leisure Activities

To ask about someone’s hobbies or free time:

- What do you do in your free time?
- Do you like listening to music?
- What do you do after school?

To answer these questions, we use the present simple tense:

- I watch TV.
- She plays the guitar.
- We go to the park.
- They read books.

Use verbs like:

watch, read, play, listen to, go, walk, rest, cook, draw, dance



Add expressions like:

- in my free time
- on the weekend
- after work
- in the evening

Real Life Example

Teacher: What do you do on Saturdays?

Student: I usually go to the park and read.

Teacher: Nice! Do you listen to music too?

Student: Yes, I love music.
