


TALK ABOUT THEIR ONLINE HABITS

You can use expressions like:

- on the internet
- on my phone
- on YouTube
- online
- with friends

To ask someone about their habits:

- Do you use social media?
- What do you do online?
- Do you watch videos or read?
- Do you play games on your tablet?

Real Life Example

Max: What do you usually do online?

Anna: I watch funny videos and play games on my phone.

Max: Me too! I also talk to my friends on WhatsApp.
