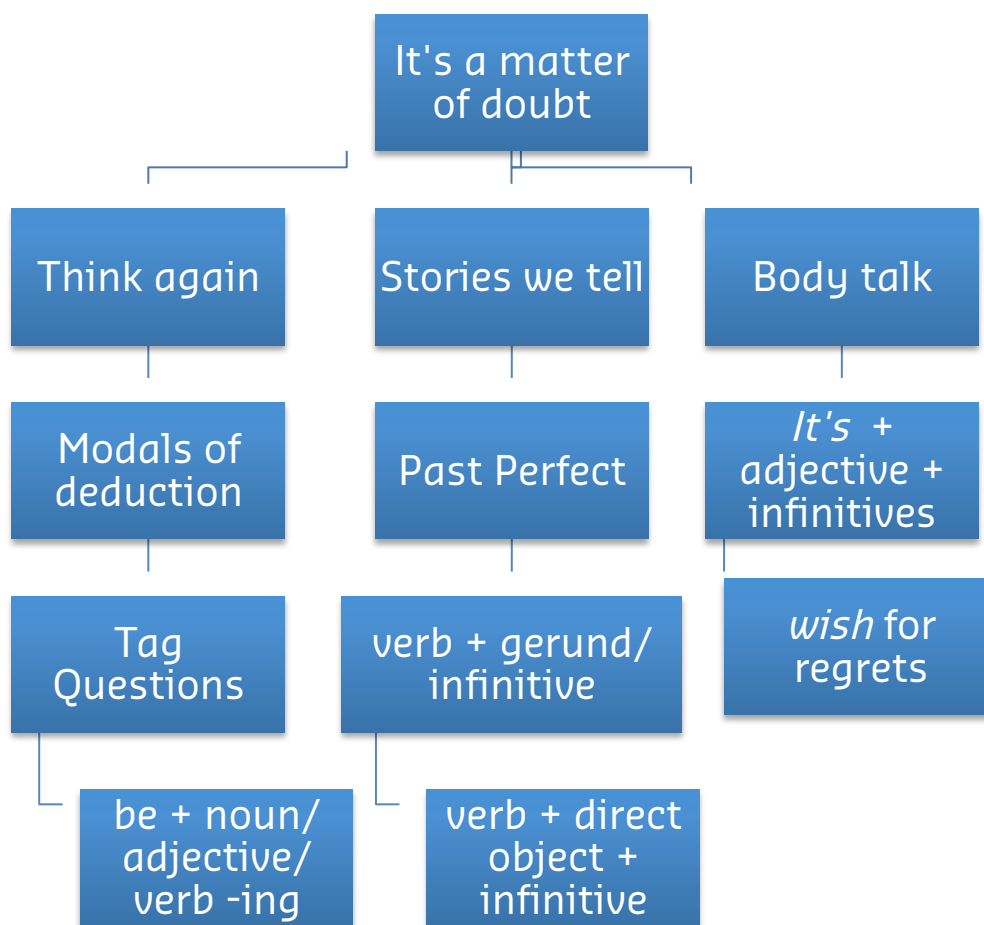
Remember that it is always important to practice your English beyond the course activities. Try it every time you have a chance!
