

Remember!

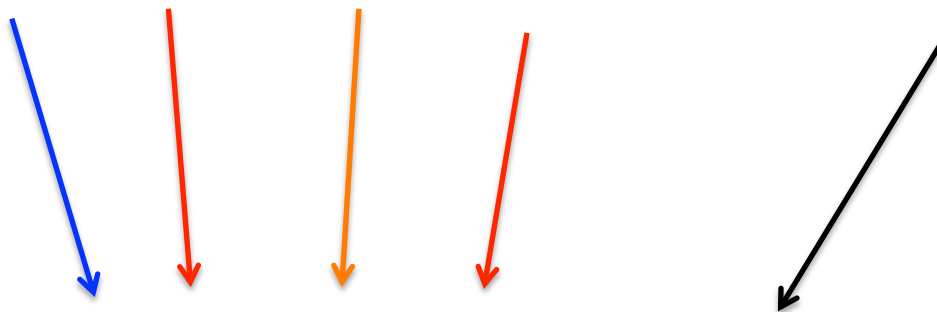
Present Perfect is a tense we use to express that we have experience doing certain activities.

- We add **already** in affirmatives to say the activity was completed before it was expected, or just to emphasize it.
- We add **yet** in negatives to emphasize that it has not been completed.

Check the way we structure them.

Affirmative:

Subject + *have/has* + *already* + (**verb in PAST PARTICIPLE**) + complement.



I have already traveled to other countries.

Remember!

Negative:

Subject + *haven't/hasn't* + (verb in PAST PARTICIPLE) + complement + *yet*.
