## INTRODUCTION TO THE UNIT

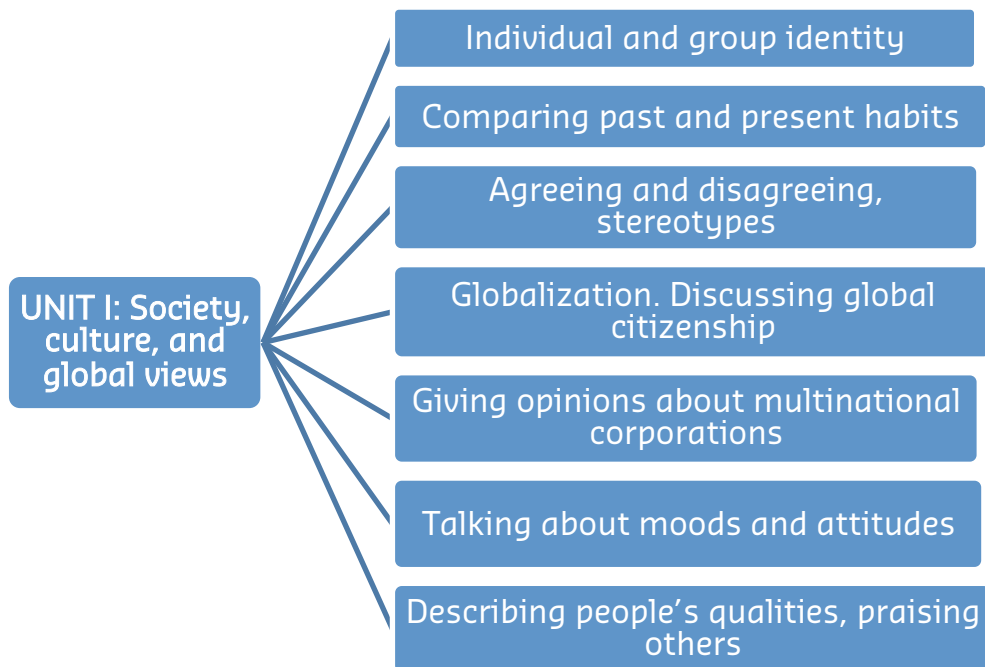
